## Its main purposes are to:

- Promote co-operation and communication between the disciplines of psychiatry, psychology, law and related fields;
- Promote research into issues and problems in forensic psychiatry, forensic psychology and areas of law and other disciplines in which psychiatry and psychology are relevant;
- Promote informed public and professional discussion about contemporary issues in forensic psychiatry, forensic psychology and areas of law and other disciplines in which psychiatry and psychology are relevant; and
- Disseminate information regarding research and developments in forensic psychiatry, forensic psychology and areas of law and other disciplines in which psychiatry and psychology are relevant.

Each year ANZAPPL sponsors a Congress hosted by one of its branches and featuring prominent keynote speakers. In addition, branches organise regular activities such as dinner meetings, symposia and workshops. ANZAPPL also produces a journal, *Psychiatry, Psychology and Law*, which has been published since 1993.

Where appropriate, participation in ANZAPPL activities may be applied to Continuing Professional Education requirements.
